In the afternoon parents are able to pick students up until 3:15 pm, please try not to arrive prior to this time so that parents may do so without having an issue getting through the car loop. If your child is truly ill, please keep them home and we will use a makeup day to test them when they can focus on showing all the great learning that has occurred this year!

On testing days normal lunch times may be changed in order to allow for the required length of time for the assessment.
