MyStudent Access –

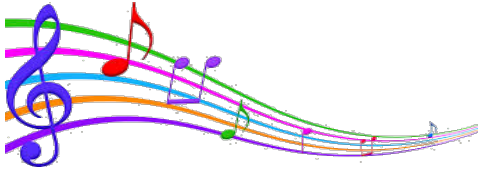
