Teacher Teaching Out of Field

As a Title 1 school, we are required to inform you when a teacher, for four or more consecutive week, does not meet certification requirements. When a teacher is out of field, FL law requires the teacher to take at least six semester hours of course work towards his/her out-of-field certification area each year until he/she is fully certified for the teaching assignment. The District is providing assistance in meeting these requirements and we have full confidence in his/her ability to teach effectively in this assignment during the 2023-2024 school year.

CRES Clothing Closet

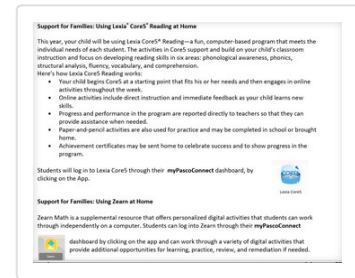

NOTICE TO BUILDING OCCUPANTS AND PARENTS

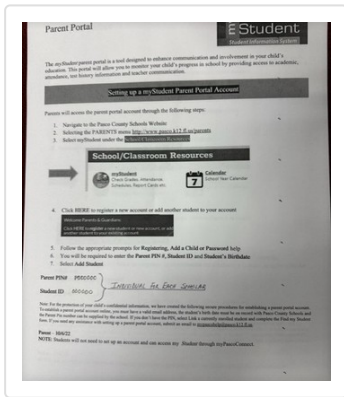
NOTIFICATION OF INSPECTION FOR ASBESTOS CONTAINING MATERIALS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued a final rule, 40 CFR Part 763, Asbestos Containing Materials in schools, commonly referred to as AHERA. This rule requires all Local Education Agencies (LEA's) to identify asbestos containing materials (ACM) in their school buildings and to take appropriate actions to control the release of asbestos fibers.

All inspections for Cotee River Elementary have been completed and a Management Plan describing the results of the inspection and the action plan to control any asbestos found during the inspection, where applicable, has been submitted to the governor for approval. A copy of this plan is in the administrative office of this school and at Pasco County Schools Maintenance & Facility Services Department and is available for review upon request.

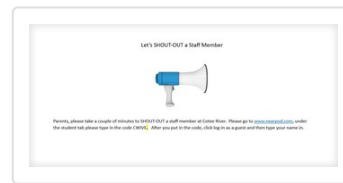
How to Update Parent Portal
